For whom and why?

The ASH Pre-Study Program prepares refugees that are not yet able to apply for a regular study program at ASH with the competences and necessary prerequisites for studies to finally enrol as a regular student.

Prerequisites for studies:

- University entrance qualification or §11 entrance through vocational qualification (2 years recognized vocational qualification in related fields and 3 years work experience in the field)
- C1 level German (DSH-2, TestDaF-TDN4, telc C1 Hochschule, Goethe Zertifikat C2)
- Internship (12 weeks, 462 hours)

How does it look like?

Structure of the ASH Pre-Study Program:

Duration: 2 Semesters (Oct. – Sept.)

- German course (level B1-C1)
- Completion of study relevant application requirements (e.g. internship for Social Work, Early Childhood Education and Physio-/ Occupational Therapy and a first aid course for Physio-/Occupational Therapy) → if you have the chance start your internship now!
- Attendance of first seminars
