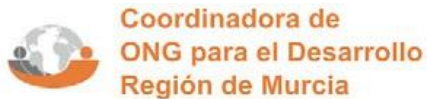

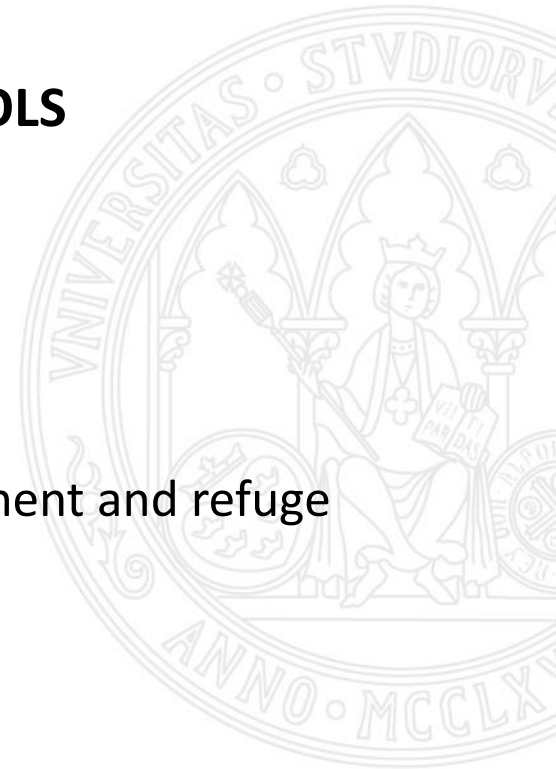

Great cost-effect ratio, for an International Relations Office

Essential: good contact with NGO (Accem, Red Cross, Cepaim Foundation and Murcia Acoge)

Some figures (since end 2016):

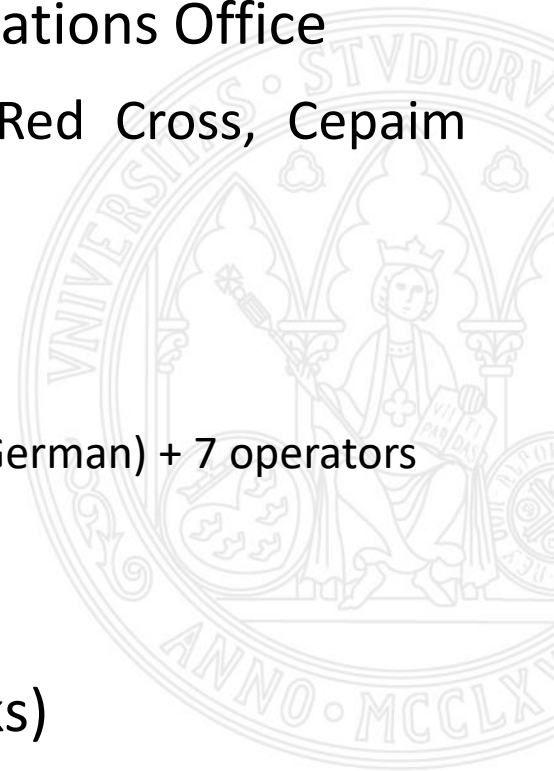
Awarded licences: 210 (110 + 100) + 7 operators

Assigned licences: 153 (103 Spanish, 47 English, 2 French, 1 German) + 7 operators

Course licences: 113 (79 Spanish, 32 English, 2 French)
